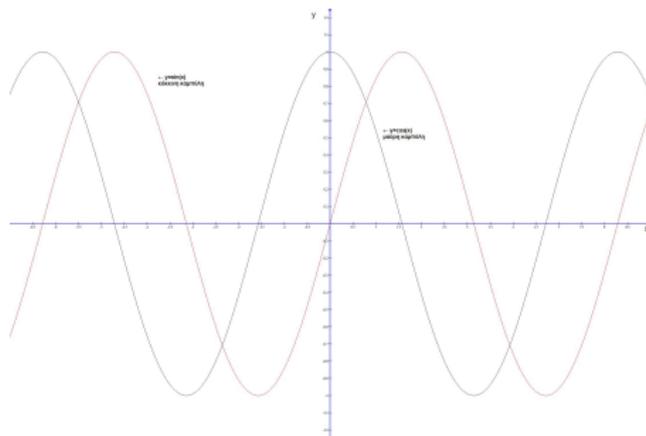


Figure 1: Sine and Cosine functions
