




The methodological framework can be applied to extend the developed tools or create new tools to estimate dose and risks from different imaging and therapeutic procedures related to the management of diseases.

SINFONIA 's key objectives are to:

- Develop dose estimation tools based on personalised dosimetry methods, advanced computational tools, powered by artificial intelligence (AI)
- Perform research on individual sensitivity to radiation and susceptibility to Second Malignant Neoplasms for risk appraisal in medicine
- Develop a novel patient radiation risk appraisal tool and estimate uncertainties
- Conduct research to support radiation risk appraisal for staff, comforters, the public and the environment
- Develop and operate a platform for dose, imaging and non-imaging data
- Provide multidisciplinary education and training

Total score: 49.00 (Threshold: 70)

Criterion 1 - RELEVANCE

Score: **10.00** (Threshold: 13/25.00 , Weight: -)

The detailed criteria are set out in the call conditions (see Call document).

The aim of developing a virtual radiation training for VET and HE **has not been sufficiently apparent within the context of EU policies**. However, **the project outputs are aligned with the EU Medical exposure directive**. **The proposal does not clearly link up with existing EU tools and initiatives for skills development**.

Developing a training programme in Radiation Protection (RP) for all staff with responsibility for medical exposure is the main objective of the proposal. Due to the skills targeted, **this aim matches one of the proprieties of the Action (A Europe fit for the digital age) in a convenient manner**.

A proper needs analysis is not presented in the proposal. Instead, there is a reference to the assumption that many professionals in health services are exposed to radiation as part of their work. This assumption is further developed with negative remarks about the current training and the increased risks of radiation exposure. However, **the proposal does not substantiate those assumptions with any data, document or research showing its importance, even at the participating institutions**. This reduces the relevance of the objectives, as there is no justification explaining the extent of the problem and the importance of the proposed solutions.

Several initiatives are mentioned to educate health professionals on radiation protection. The creation of a new collaborative learning platform


